

**Commonwealth Elite Karate Championships**

**Competition Information**

The SKGB invites you organisation to participate in the above Elite Championship. This kumite and kata competition will be open to governing body selected competitors only. All competitors must be 18 years old and above for kumite events and 16 years and above for kata.

**Team events:**

In the kumite events each country will be allowed 1 male team (5 per team) and 1 female team (3 per team) and in the kata event, each country will be allowed one male team (3 per team) and one female team (3 per team)

**Individual events:**

In individual categories (listed on the attached sheet) each country will be allowed four kumite competitors per weight category and four kata competitors. Category information is outlined on the attached category information sheet.

Individual events (Kumite and Kata) entry fees:

- Adult (18 years and above) Kumite £15.00
- Adult (16 years and above) Kata £15.00

Team Events (Kumite and Kata) entry fees:

- Adult Team Kumite (18 years and above) £30.00 (Male team of 5)
- Adults Team Kumite (18 years and above) £20.00 (Female team of 3)
- Kata Teams (16 years and above) £20.00 (Male/Female)

**Dress code**

Referees and officials should adhere to WKF dress code. Coaches should be in track suits. At time of presentation of trophies all competitors due to be presented must be dressed in karate Gi or track suit.

**Check in**

All competitors must check and weigh in at least 30 minutes before official start time.

**Spectator's fees**

- 1 day ticket £10.00 (adult) Children (under 16 years) £5.00
- 2 day ticket £15.00 (adult) Children (under 16 years) £8.00
- Family ticket 1 day £20.00 (2 adults 2 children under 16 years)
- Family ticket 2 day £30.00 (2 adults 2 children under 16 years)

Entry fees must be sent with completed entry forms from all UK associations. Entry fees from associations out with the UK can be paid on the day of competition in **pounds sterling**.

Entry forms should be completed, giving all required information and returned to **Hamish Adam**, tournament organiser, 10 Waterloo Bank, Penicuik, Midlothian EH26 8NS, Scotland UK by **Friday 2nd May 2008**.
