

CKF OPEN Championships

The SKGB invites and welcomes you to participate in the above CKF OPEN Championship. This kumite and kata competition will be open to Children 8-15 years, cadets 16 and 17 years old and adults 18 years and above. All cadet and adult categories will be held on Saturday 31st MAY followed by children's events on Sunday 1st JUNE 2008.

Kata

In the children's Kata events any kata can be performed and repeated in subsequent rounds. For adults competing in the kata event WKF rules apply. Entry fees are as follows:

Kata fees

- Children (under 15 years) £10.00
- Adults (16 years and above) £15.00

Kumite - Individual and Team Events

Children's kumite (8-15 years) all bouts will be of a two minute duration. Cadet and adult kumite WKF rules apply. Team kumite, each team should consist of three members, for the children's team events all members should be from the same category. Please note that there is no limit to the amount of entries you can put forward in any category. Entry fees are as follows

Individual Fees

- Children (8-15 years) £10.00
- Cadet (16 and 17 years) £15.00
- Adult (18 years and above) £15.00

Team Fees

- Under 8-15 years teams (3 members per team) £15.00
- Cadet teams (3 members per team) £20.00
- Adult teams (3 members per team) £20.00

Dress code

Referees and officials should adhere to WKF dress code. Coaches should be in track suits. At time of presentation of trophies all competitors due to be presented must be dressed in karate Gi or track suit.

Check in

All competitors must check and weigh in at least 30 minutes before official start time.

Spectator's fees

- 1 day ticket £10.00 (adult) Children (under 16 years) £5.00
- 2 day ticket £15.00 (adult) Children (under 16 years) £8.00
- Family ticket 1 day £20.00 (2 adults 2 children under 16 years)
- Family ticket 2 day £30.00 (2 adults 2 children under 16 years)

Entry fees must be sent with completed entry forms from all UK associations. Entry fees from associations out with the UK can be paid on the day of competition in pounds sterling. Cheques made payable to SKGB Ltd. Entry forms should be completed, giving all required information and returned to:
